



2009/2010 OFF SEASON SERVICE CONTRACT INFORMATION

Gordy's Platinum Plan

We take all the guesswork out of servicing your boat. Our Platinum Plan is a complete engine and drive service plan that includes the necessary services to maintain warranty and keep your boat in tip-top shape. We will check your boat history and perform the necessary services during the off season.

For boaters not choosing platinum plan, please select all desired service.

1. Gordy's Winter Storage Pricing

☞ All boats stored at Gordy's are indoors, no boats will be left outside!

☞ Hauling charges vary depending on boat location and size

Pick up by trailer or water up to 29' ~ \$150/hr

Boats exceeding 29' with hydraulic trailer & truck ~ \$8 /ft

☞ Boats without keys will result in a \$25 fee

☞ Piers / lifts without power will result in an additional fee for man and equipment

2. Annual Engine / boat service

☞ Winterizing engine(s) ~ Mandatory for Wisconsin Winters!

Add Full Throttle fuel stabilizer to fuel tank - prevents formation of gum and varnish. Run engine and fog - prevents rust and corrosion of internal parts. Drain cooling system water and flush with antifreeze - prevents freezing and cracking of parts. Remove block plugs, exhaust manifold plugs and disconnect hoses and battery. Inspect propeller for damage and send out unless specifically noted.

All in/out customers will be winterized after October 15th.

☞ Additional Winterizing

Gordy's will flush water systems with antifreeze to avoid damage i.e.. ballast bags, porta potti, head, air conditioning, fresh water, etc.

☞ Pump Holding Tank / Porta Potti

All holding tanks and porta potti's must be pumped prior to hauling out of the water.

☞ Pre Spring Commission ****Must be done prior to boat launch***

Install drain plugs, exhaust manifold plugs. Reconnect all hoses. Charge and reconnect battery. Run engine on hose or in test tank prior to launch, check fluid levels. Verify normal shifting engagement.

☞ Engine Service

Check cooling, fuel, and electrical systems. Change engine oil, oil filter, and fuel water separator. Check power steering and power trim fluids and fill if needed.

☞ Lower Unit Service

Visually inspect lower unit, bellows and hoses. Lubricate transom assembly, engine coupler, and steering. Change lower unit oil.

☞ IAC (Idle Air Control) - Remove and replace IAC filter.

☞ Gimbal Ring U-Bolt - Re-torque U-bolt. Reduces gimbal ring failure.

☞ In-Line Fuel Filter - Necessary on all 2002 and newer boats.

☞ Cool Fuel III fuel filter - 2005 and newer boats.

☞ Torque manifold nuts

- ☞ Outdrive Service (Alpha / Bravo) *Every other year starting first year on all new boats.
Remove outdrive. Grease u-joints and check engine alignment. Visually inspect bellows. Remove prop, check prop shaft and reinstall prop. Install outdrive. Check shifting operation.
- ☞ Water Pump Impeller (Bravo) *Every other year
Major engine failure possible if not replaced. Impeller draws lake water to cool engine.
- ☞ Major Tune Up *Every three years
Remove and replace distributor cap, rotor, and spark plugs (points and condensers if nec).
- ☞ Tune Up (496 engines only) *Every three years
Remove and replace spark plugs
- ☞ Water Pump Impeller (Alpha) *Every four years
Major engine failure possible if not replaced. Impeller draws lake water to cool engine. When completing this work, it is required that the lower unit service is completed at the same time.

3. Generator Service (For boats 30' and larger) *Every year

- ☞ Winterize at the end of each season
- ☞ Summerize prior to boat launch in the spring
- ☞ Generator oil and impeller should be replaced annually

4. Prop Repair

- ☞ Prop Repair
All props will be sent out for repair unless specifically instructed. Gordy's professional staff will assess the damage and repair as necessary. Please instruct us if you decline this service.

5. Hull Cleaning

- ☞ Hull cleaning
All boats will be cleaned with muriatic acid and hand washed with soap and water prior to winter storage. The amount of cleaning will depend on the summer mooring location of your boat.

6. Battery Service

- ☞ Battery Service - All batteries 3 years and older will be replaced unless specified by customer.

7. Boat Detailing

- ☞ Basic - Exterior wash and interior touch up (surface only)
- ☞ Gold - Exterior wash and interior detail excluding compartments. There will be a basic wipe down of compartments without removing any personal items.
- ☞ Premium - Exterior wash, hand wax, full interior detail and wash boat covers
- ☞ Ultimate - Exterior wash, 3-step buff, hand wax, shampoo carpets, polish stainless, full interior detail and covers

8. Trailer Service

- ☞ Trailer Inspection
Inspect trailer; set tire pressure, grease wheel bearings and check all lights
- ☞ Trailer Maintenance
Trailer service; remove wheels, check brakes, re-pack bearings and check coupler.

Gordy's Additional Services

- ☞ Bottom Paint
For those boats needing bottom paint. Boats are taped off, hoisted and painted with anti-fouling paint to decrease algae growth. (Not recommended for new Cobalts)
- ☞ Fiberglass / Gel coat / Wet Sand Repairs
Gordy's service department has a state-of-the-art fiberglass shop. All repairs will be thoroughly inspected and an estimate will be given prior to any repairs. Our in house fiberglass specialist can repair any type of summer damage.
